### Directions to Alaska Flight 261 Memorial and Monument

Exit hotel parking lot and turn right on Ventura Road.  
Go to the end of the street (2 blocks) and turn left onto Surfside Drive.  
Go approximately a half mile and turn left onto Ocean View Drive.  
Park in the parking lot and walk onto the beach.  
Driving time approximately 4 minutes. Walking time approximately 20 minutes.

### Directions to Boat Cruise to Alaska Flight 261 Site

Exit hotel parking lot via the Hueneme Road exit, and turn right.  
Make immediate left turn onto Ventura Road.  
Go approximately 2 miles north on Ventura Road to East Channel Islands Blvd.  
Turn left on East Channel Islands Blvd, and go approximately 2 miles to West Channel Islands Blvd.  
Turn left onto Harbor Blvd., and go to 3600 S. Harbor Blvd. (left side of road)  
Driving time approximately 15 minutes. Approximately miles=5

### Directions to Church/Religious Services

*NOTE: No formal services are scheduled at St. Maximilian Kolbe Catholic Church for Families of Alaska Flight 261.  
Masses on Sunday, January 31<sup>st</sup>, are at 7:30 am, 9:00 am and 11:00 am*

- **St. Maximilian Kolbe Catholic Church**

Exit hotel parking lot via the Hueneme Road exit, and turn right.  
Continue east on Hueneme Road for approximately 5 miles until you get to Las Posas Road.  
Turn left on Las Posas Road and go north approximately 4 miles.  
At the intersection of the 101 freeway and Las Posas Road, enter the 101 freeway going east towards Los Angeles.  
Stay on the 101 freeway for approximately 15 miles until you get to Lindero Canyon Road, Exit 39.  
Exit the freeway at Lindero Canyon Road, Exit 39.  
At the light, turn left onto Lindero Canyon Road, and go north for approximately 3 miles.  
At Kanan Road, turn left and make immediate right into the church parking lot.  
Driving time approximately 40 minutes. Approximately miles=40

### Directions to Alaska Flight 261 Cemetery

Exit hotel parking lot via the Hueneme Road exit, and turn right.  
Continue east on Hueneme Road for approximately 5 miles until you get to Las Posas Road.  
Turn left on Las Posas Road and go north approximately 4 miles.  
At the intersection of the 101 freeway and Las Posas Road, enter the 101 freeway going east towards Los Angeles.  
Stay on the 101 freeway for approximately 15 miles until you get to Lindero Canyon Road, Exit 39.  
Exit the freeway at Lindero Canyon Road, Exit 39.  
At the light, turn left onto Lindero Canyon Road, and go north for approximately a half mile (cemetery is just north of the freeway on the right hand side).  
Driving time approximately 35 minutes. Approximately miles=37

### Directions to Point Mugu Beach

Exit hotel parking lot via the Hueneme Road exit, and turn right.  
Stay on Hueneme Road approximately 4 miles until you see the Highway 1 entrance toward Santa Monica on your right.  
Get on Highway 1 towards Santa Monica for approximately 1 mile and exit at Exit 108 at Wood Road/US Navy Point Mugu exit.  
Turn left on Naval Air Road. Go 1 mile to **Point Mugu Gate 2** (Main Entrance). Go to the Gate Guard.  
Driving time approximately 15 minutes. Approximately miles=9
